Haritha Haram is a large-scale tree planting program implemented by the Government of Telangana to increase the amount of tree cover in the state from 24% to 33%.

Importance of Haritha Haram

It is one of the Telangana flagship programmes to regenerate degraded forests, protecting these forests from threats such as logging, encroachment, fire and grazing. It adopted intensive soil and moisture conservation measures based on a watershed approach.

* It was launched in 2015 by the chief minister K. Chandrababu Naidu. It also plans to regenerate degraded forests.
