1. Institutional Training :-

a. Institutional training conducted at colleges and schools is the mainstay of NCC training and is conducted by Associate NCC officers and Armed Forces personnel. The syllabus comprises common subjects and service subjects in the ratio 70:30.

* Leader Ship Camps. Six Advance
