



Assam Flood

Assam's flood situation is still grave, with nearly 7 lakh people in 31 districts affected by the flood. In the districts of Nagaon, Hojai, Cachar, Darrang, Morigaon and Karimgaoni, the flood situation is still dire. According to statistics from the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) approximately 3.40 lakh people have been affected in Nagaon district alone, with 1.78 lakh in Cachar, 70,283 in Hojai, 44,382 in Darrang, 17,776 in Morigaon, and 16,382 in Karimgaoni.

Nearly four lakh animals were affected by the current wave of floods in the state.

A total of 24,749 stranded persons have been rescued with the help of the Indian Army, State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and volunteers.
