

## Agni-V

India on Wednesday successfully test-fired its longest range surface-to-surface ballistic missile, Agni-V.

"A successful launch of the surface-to-surface ballistic missile, Agni-V, was carried out on October 27, 2021 at approximately 1950 hrs from APJ Abdul Kalam Island, Odisha," the Defence Ministry said.

The three-stage solid-fuelled engine missile is capable of striking targets at ranges up to 5,000 km with a very high degree of accuracy and can reach most parts of China. It has already been containerised which improves the ease of handling and operation.
