The Bharat Ratna is India's highest civilian award which is conferred to people in recognition of their exceptional service in any field without distinction of race, occupation or made by the prime ministers of India of the present. On conferment of the award the recipient receives a star and certificate signed by the president and medallion. The award does not carry any monetary grant. It was first awarded in 1954 to Pt. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan, Dr. C. V. Raman.
